Many years ago now, I traveled to Seattle Washington to visit the family of a young woman I had begun dating (and would eventually marry!). The region is a breathtaking part of our great country with lush green hills and wild running rivers. There is a reason, however, that it is the city famous for its coffee: it is nearly always cloudy and wet.

I flew in for that first visit on a rare, partly-sunny day. When I got to my future in-laws' home, they asked me a perplexing question: "On the drive down," they asked, "was the mountain out?"

The mountain they were referring to was Mount Rainier: the towering, 14,000 foot snow capped mountain which looms over the Seattle metro area. It is visible from all around the region and is a breathtaking sight to behold. Due to how cloudy the area is, you can easily go an entire week without seeing it. When the sun shines and the clouds clear, however, the locals quickly announce: the mountain is out!

This spring it has felt like the clouds are breaking and the sun is beginning to shine. We have been blessed in countless ways by the working of the Holy Spirit among us. It is rare for Pastor Devyn and I to go more than a few days without hearing a praise of God's work in one of your lives. What better time then to take in the sight of God at work and to begin to look forward to how God might be calling and leading our congregation into the future.

On Saturday, May 21st, we will have a chance to do this work together with a conversation and workshop entitled "Higher Elevations: Managing Momentum, Mission and Ministry." Everyone is encouraged to attend; it runs from 9:00 a.m. until Noon in the church sanctuary. Rev. Doug Bixby, lead pastor of the Covenant Church in Attleboro, will guide our time. He will help us consider the potential for mission and ministry, how to avoid pitfalls which block growth, and lean into our strengths as a congregation. It promises to be an engaging time.

"The mountain is out!" Instead of walking with our heads down in the cloudy valleys, let's join in the hike up the mountain to "higher elevations". Like the disciples who joined Jesus on the mountain and saw his glory in

the transfiguration; we can join in our journey with Jesus and gaze on his glorious work in our midst. If you cannot join us, pray for our time together; if you can, please plan on attending. And in all of this season, let us give thanks to Christ who clears the skies and the way for us.


From the Church Office


Care Ministry
